For the first time publications will be electronic except for invited keynote presentations. Most important to note is that, in contrast to past meetings, all presenters must submit both an abstract and a short research paper, and all papers are to be submitted before the symposium. To reiterate, in order to present an oral paper or poster at the 10th ISAES, each author must have submitted an abstract and short research paper by the submission deadline.
